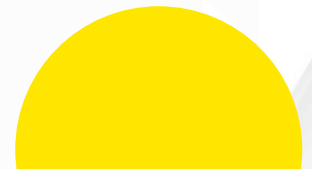


Students presented a meaningful skit highlighting the importance of nursing services and patient care.
